PUBLIC CIRCULAR NO. 5/2026

The Ministry of Labour hereby informs the general public, employers, foreign nationals, and all stakeholders that the Work Permit System is now fully operational following the successful completion of scheduled maintenance and system upgrades.

The Ministry further wishes to notify all applicants and stakeholders that:

1. **Processing Time:** Work permit applications process takes **ten (10) to fourteen (14) working days** from the date of complete submission, provided all requirements are met.
2. **Collection Procedure:** Issued work permits must be collected in person by the **applicant**.
3. **Identification Requirement:** Original passport identification is mandatory at the time of collection. Work permits will strictly not be released to any third party under any circumstances.

The Ministry appreciates the public's patience, understanding, and continued cooperation during the maintenance period and encourages all stakeholders to adhere to the above procedures to ensure smooth and efficient service delivery.

The Ministry remains committed to improving service delivery and ensuring the effective administration of labour procedures nationwide.
