PUBLIC CIRCULAR

The Ministry of Labour hereby informs the general public, foreign nationals, employers, and all stakeholders that the Ministry has not deployed any officer or representative to Juba International Airport for work permit, labour inspection, fee collection, or any other labour-related services.

The Ministry further wishes to clarify that all work permit applications, payments, fees, and other labour-related processes are conducted exclusively through the official offices and authorized channels of the Ministry of Labour.

Accordingly, members of the public are advised that:

- No work permit or labour-related payments should be made at Juba International Airport; and
- Any person requiring labour services is advised to process such matters directly through the Ministry of Labour.
