Rotary Partnership Delivers Four Customized Ambulances to Improve Healthcare Access in Twic County



Turalei, Twic County, Warrap State | July 2026 — Four customized motor tricycle ambulances have been handed over to Transformation of the World in Christ (TWIC) to strengthen emergency healthcare services for remote and displaced communities across Twic County, Warrap State.

The ambulances were donated primarily by Festival Medical Services through a partnership between the MAMA Project and the Rotary Club of Wau.

Locally known as tuk-tuks, the three-wheeled vehicles have been transformed from cargo carriers into community ambulances. Each is fitted with a patient bed and mattress, a basic first aid kit, and a reinforced frame designed by PULSE Ltd. in Uganda to withstand the muddy roads and challenging terrain common in Twic County, particularly during the rainy season.

The ambulances were officially received by Rev. Pastor Paul Lueth, Executive Director of TWIC, and will transport expectant mothers, children, and emergency patients from remote villages to Mother Teresa Hospital in Turalei — where timely access to medical care can mean the difference between life and death.

"We are deeply grateful to the MAMA Project, the Rotary Clubs, and all the generous donors for this life-saving support," said Rev. Pastor Paul Lueth. "These ambulances will greatly improve access to healthcare for our communities. We also look forward to the arrival of maternity kits, which will complement this initiative. Our biggest challenge now is maintaining the ambulances and meeting fuel costs, and we appeal to partners and well-wishers to help keep this vital service running."

The project reflects Rotary's ongoing commitment to improving maternal and community healthcare through sustainable partnerships and practical, locally appropriate solutions. By adapting affordable vehicles for difficult rural conditions, the initiative delivers a reliable emergency transport system in areas where conventional ambulances often cannot reach.

The Rotary Club of Wau extends its sincere appreciation to the MAMA Project, the supporting Rotary Clubs in the United States and South Sudan, TWIC, and all donors whose generosity has brought hope and life-saving healthcare closer to the people of Twic County.

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
