RE: FALSE SOCIAL MEDIA CLAIMS ATTRIBUTED TO H.E. GEN. LOUIS LOBONG LOJORE

The Office of H.E. the Governor of Eastern Equatoria State, wishes to categorically refute the false and misleading social media claims alleging that His Excellency referred to Hon. Gen. Isaac Mamur Mette as a "half minister" during the recent SPLM Summit.

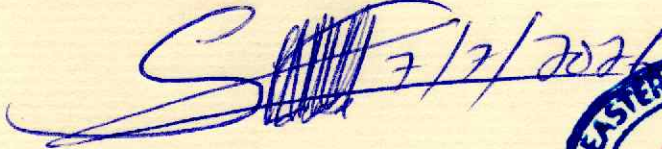
H.E. the Governor never made such statement and did not mention the name of Hon. Gen. Isaac Mamur Mette at any point during his presentation.

During the presentation, His Excellency's remarks focused solely on the need for equitable representation of Eastern Equatoria State within the SPLM Party and the National Executive. He noted that the State is represented by only two members in the SPLM Political Bureau and currently holds one national ministerial portfolio, which is not a service-delivery ministry. His appeal was for fair and balanced representation of the State in national institutions.

The circulating statement is a deliberate fabrication by the enemies of peace intended only to mislead the public, create division among our great leaders, and undermine the unity, peace, and progress of our people.

The Office therefore urges the public to disregard this false propaganda, refrain from sharing unverified information, and rely only on official sources for accurate communication.

H.E. Gen. Louis Lobong Lojore maintains cordial and respectful relations with Hon. Gen. Isaac Mamur Mette and all national leaders and remains committed to promoting unity, peace, and equitable representation for Eastern Equatoria State and the Republic of South Sudan.


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
